FAQs

Q. How do I find out if I am eligible for work-study?

If you applied for financial aid through the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships, you can check whether they awarded you work-study funds on your "My Aid Award" page.

Q. Where do I go to get more information about work-study awards?

The Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships provides detailed information about using work-study funds on your "My To-Do List" page.

Q. Where do I find work-study jobs?

The Career Center can help you search for the right work-study job through their professional staff, peer advisors, and online via Handshake.

Q. What happens if I don't use my work-study?

If you fail to use your work-study, you run the risk of losing it.

Q. Is it possible to work off campus and earn work-study?

There are a limited number of positions off campus that offer work-study. Check Handshake for the most up to date listings of available positions.

Q. Can I work in two different departments and still collect work-study?

Yes, but you have to collect a signed agreement form from each department.
